Silva Family Wines Cabernet Sauvignon/Carmenère 2015, Colchagua Valley, Chile

A terrific intense and fresh, wine with aromas of ripe red fruits and toffee. Soft tannins and cherry notes that lead into an agreeable finish.

Berticot, Côtes de Duras, Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Garonne, France

Dry in style, this delicious white offers aromas of blackcurrant leaf and freshly cut grass, and the taste of ripe gooseberries. A fantastic all-rounder.

Classic Club Claret

Château La Tuilerie du Puy 2012/13, Bordeaux Supérieur, France

This is amazing Claret for the price! Enjoy the scent and taste of sweet, juicy blackcurrants and blackberries, backed by the support of firm tannins. Great with red meat dishes. £19.60

Classic Club White

Château La Tuilerie du Puy 2013, "Entre-Deux-Mers", France

This Entre-Deux-Mers has good aromas of grapefruit and exotic fruits. Soft in the mouth with pleasant freshness. On the palate has fruity aromatic persistence and notes of white flowers and citrus. £19.60

Club Champagne

Guy Charbaut Brut, NV, Mareuil-sur-Ay, France

Made from Chardonnay, Pinot noir and Pinot Meunier vine varieties, grown on rich chalky soils around Mareuil-sur-Ay. This fine medium bodied Champagne has a full mousse and lovely nose. £56.00

WHITE WINES

Dr. Loosen Estate Riesling, 2013, Germany

This is a characteristic Riesling from the Mosel with a fragrant nose, lime and sherbet with hints of honey and green apricot fruit. Refreshing, juicy acidity and a touch of elegance, poise, balance and dangerously quaffable. £27.30

Chardonnay Macon-Villages 2014, Vin De Bourgogne, France

An elegant wine with ripe citrus fruit, crisp acidity and a honeyed finish. £28.10

Aigle Nior Viognier 2014, Pays D'Oc, France

Intense bouquet of white flowers. The mouth is very rich with aromas of tropical fruits, dried apricots, hazelnuts and honey. The finish is crispy and lively. £23.00

Viña Casa Silva Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2014, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Chilean SB is generally less pungent than its New Zealand or French cousins, so choose this if you want a light white that still bounces with green, herbaceous flavours. £24.30

Delheim Chenin Blanc 2014, Stellenbosch, South Africa

An incredibly zesty wine packed with lively lemon and peachy fruit. A great stylistic wine with a creaminess and touch of honey that marks it out a Chenin. £24.25

Pouilly-Fumé En Travertin 2015, France

The aromatic, floral and smoked nature of the Sauvignon grape variety is the most dominant aspect of the charming wine. Elegant, fruitiness and roundness and is very persistent in the mouth. A marvellous accompaniment to shellfish, fish, white meats and goats cheese. £35.20

Mariner Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc 2014, Marlborough, New Zealand

A premium wine that shines with sunny passion fruit, pineapple and melon fruit. This is pretty lush stuff by NZSB standards, but it retains a characteristic zing. £34.00

RED WINES

Fleurie Chapelle des Bois 2012, Beaujolais, France

This Organic wine has great structure, depth of flavour and length. Soft flavours of summer fruits especially cherry and strawberries. £41.00

Château Haut Piquat 2010 Lussac St Emilion, France

Situated at the edge of Lussac, this is a fine wine with a deep purple colour and complex nose of red fruits and vanilla. Goes very well with meat, game and cheese. £31.25

Château de Callac 2010, Graves, Bordeaux, France

A beautifully restrained Claret with perfumed, berry fruit, subtle nuances of oak and a lovely, savoury edge. Remarkably well priced for its quality. £33.10

Casa Silva Pinot Noir 2014 Reserva, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Red with violet hues, on the nose, fruity with notes of strawberries, on the plate, fresh, with good acidity, very agreeable tannins and note of ripe red fruit. £23.50

Château Lafitte 2013, Côtes de Bordeaux CB, France

A rich concentrated wine with hints of red fruits, structured and well balanced with good length. £38.60

Château Bouscalt 2004, Graves, Bordeaux, France

This Grand Cru Classé De Graves is a classic rich full bodied wine with complexity, elegant Structure, good length and ripe tannins offers fantastic value for money. £63.20

ROSÉ WINES

Pinot Grigio Rose, 2013, Casata Monfort, Italy

Excellent as an aperitif, a blush wine with an intense fruity and spicy bouquet, agreeable and well balanced on the palate. £26.40

DESSERT WINE

Delheim Edelspatz 2014, Stellenbosch, South Africa (37.5cl bottle)

Single Vineyard Noble Late Harvest Rhine Riesling. Aromas of dried apricot, quince and cumquat. Elegant and intense with ripe fruit and well balanced acidity. £22.50

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINES

Moët et Chandon Brut Imperial Champagne NV, France

One of the timeless classics. The tongue-tingling prick of each bursting bubble releases a sea of rich flavours, liquid brioche, hazelnuts and all-butter biscuits.

Anna de Codorníu Reserva Cava Brut NV, Spain (20cl bottle)

A lively, dry sparkling wine, produced by the traditional method, that is often described as “feminine” owing to the high proportion of Chardonnay grapes used in the blend. £8.70

Vino dei Poeti Prosecco NV, Veneto, Italy

Delightfully light and refreshing, this fizz delivers an alluring bouquet of wild flowers and the appetizing taste of orchard fruits. £29.15

PORT

The Naval Club Shooting Port

A terrific, everyday Port that is fairly light-bodied, though there's plenty of flavour to make up for any lack of weight.
